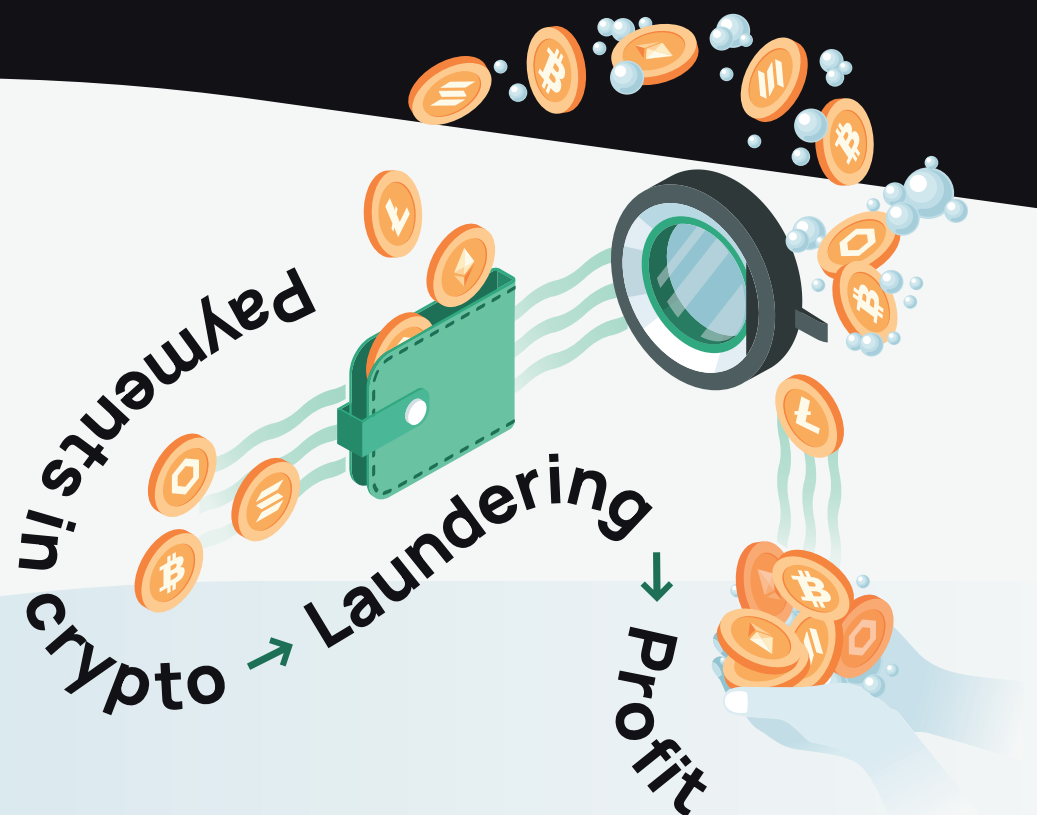

How the Money Flows

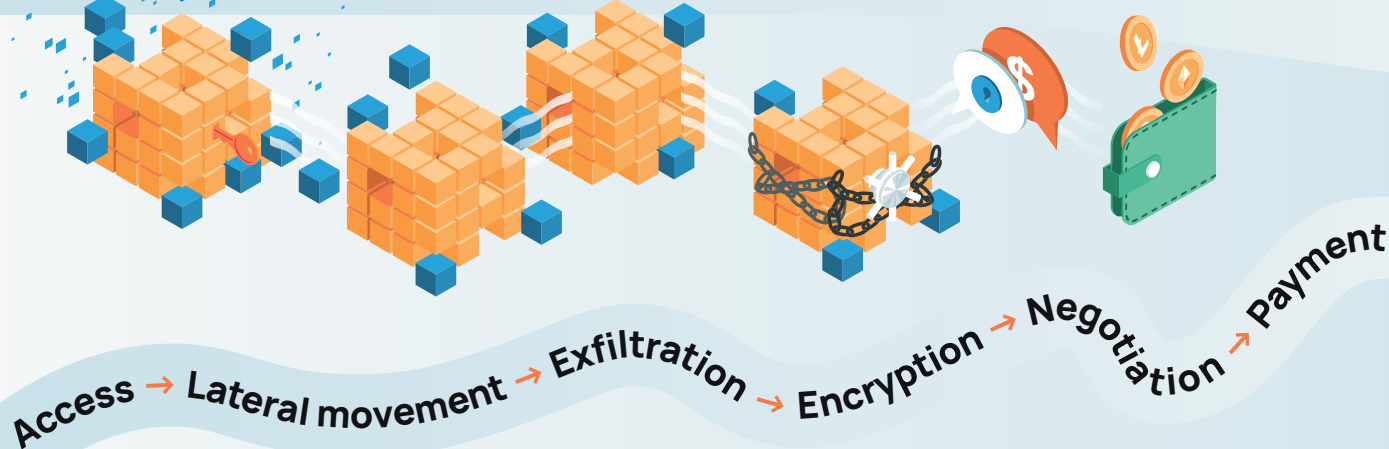
